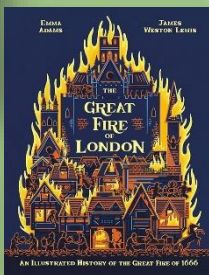
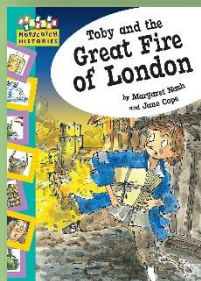
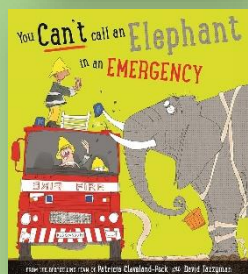
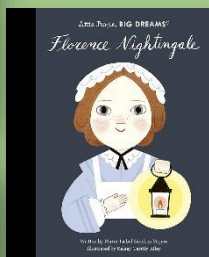
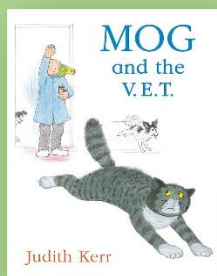




Beavers Summer Term 1 2024 Newsletter

Our class texts...



Key learning this half term:

This term our topic is 'People who help us'.

In Year 1 phonics we will continue to use Little Wandle to ensure our children can read fluently and with prosody and understanding. This term we will continue to learn the phase 5 sounds, ready for the Phonics Screening Check next half term. Your child will continue to receive their new Little Wandle decodable or fluency reading book and their chosen reading for pleasure book every Friday. Please encourage your child to read at home with you - if they do this 3 times per week, they will receive 3 dojo points! In Year 2 spelling we will be continuing with the spelling units using the new Little Wandle spelling scheme.

In Writing we will be looking at both fiction and non-fiction texts. We will enjoy writing stories and newspaper reports!

In Maths, Year 1's will be looking at fractions, numbers to 100, and time. Year 2's will be looking at fractions, time, and volume.

In Geography we will be looking at villages, towns and cities; focusing on where we live! In History we will be looking at Florence Nightingale and what her impact has been on the NHS. In Science we will be continuing to learn about everyday materials and their properties.

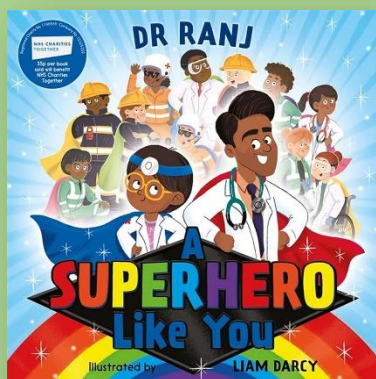

In Computing we will be learning about digital writing!
