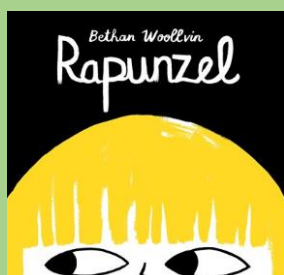
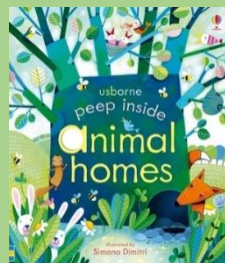
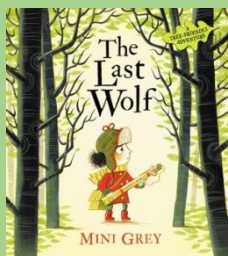
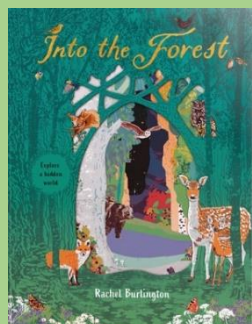


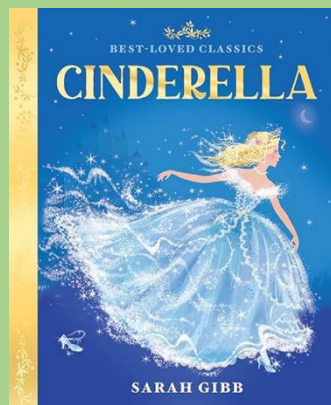


# Beavers Spring Term 1 2024 Newsletter

Remind yourself of our visit to watch the Pantomime last year and get lost in the classical fairy tale of Cinderella!

## Key learning this half term:

This term our topic is 'Into the Woods'. We are looking forward to looking at lots of different traditional tales over the next few weeks!

In Year 1 phonics we will continue to use Little Wandle to ensure our children can read fluently and with prosody and understanding. This term we will continue to learn the phase 5 sounds. Your child will continue to receive their new Little Wandle decodable or fluency reading book and their chosen reading for pleasure book every Friday. Please encourage your child to read at home with you - if they do this 3 times per week, they will receive 3 dojo points! In Year 2 spelling we will be moving on to the spelling units using the new Little Wandle spelling scheme.

In Writing we will be looking at both fiction and non-fiction texts. We will enjoy writing fairy tales, invitations and diaries!

In Maths our Year 1's will be looking at length and height and numbers to 40. Our Year 2's will be looking at mass and temperature, pictograms, word problems and money.

In Geography we will be looking at the differences between a city and the countryside and creating maps. In History we will be revisiting our learning on explorers old and new. In Science we will be learning about plants.

In DT, we will be making our own moving storybooks. In Music we will be learning about lots of different styles of music, focusing on the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch.

In Computing we will be learning about algorithms and having a go at making robots move!

In PE we will be doing gymnastics.

In PSHE we will be thinking about our dreams and goals. In RE we will be learning about salvation and how Christians ask for forgiveness.
