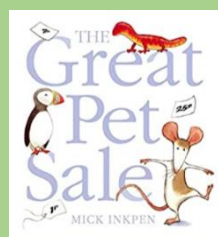
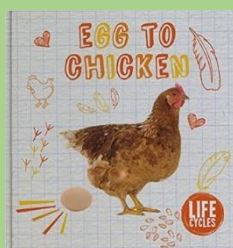
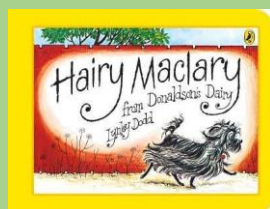
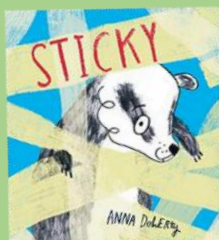
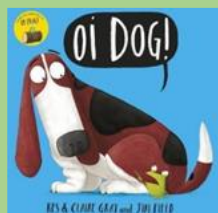




Otters Spring Term 2 - 2024 Newsletter

Key learning this half term:

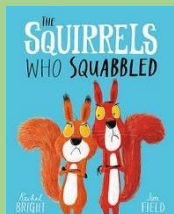
This term in Otters Class we are exploring the topic 'All Creatures Great and Small'.
